

Transfer Station Stickers for 2019 can be purchased at the Board of Health Office in the Town Hall Annex on any Wednesday from 10am to 2pm, and from 4pm – 6pm Wednesdays during December. The cost for the 2 year sticker is \$40.00; additional stickers up to 2 per household are \$5.00. Please bring in proof of residence (tax bill, light bill, etc.) and your vehicle registration for each vehicle requiring a sticker. If there are any additional days that the stickers will be sold it will be posted at the Transfer Station and on the door of the Town Hall Annex.
