

Symptoms of rabies may include unexplained aggression, impaired locomotion, varying degrees of paralysis, and extreme depression or viciousness. Individual animals maybe affected in different ways. Some animals will display the well known "vicious" form, while others, displaying the "dumb" form, will merely appear sick or dazed and become very lethargic. Once an animal begins to show signs of rabies it is likely to die within 5 days. All dogs must wear a collar or harness with their tag or identification.

The Town of Phillipston census will be mailed out for January 15, 2023.

All information given on the Census is confidential. The data collected is very important for Federal and State funding to our town. With out your information emergency personal will find it more difficult to respond and know who maybe in the home that may need help.

It is time to License all dogs that live in Phillipston - A dog licensing form will be sent with each census form and there is a form here in newsletter.

Dog Licenses for 2023 License your dog with the Town Clerk

All dogs licensed after April 1st will have a \$5.00 late fee added to their license cost Dogs licensed after May 1st will pay a \$25.00 late fee

All dogs not licensed will receive a \$50.00 fine

You can license your dog by mail, and you will find the application printed in this newsletter. Make a check out to The Town of Phillipston for the cost of the license.

No postage necessary if you drop off your licensing info at the Town Hall Mail slot on the front door. Your license will be processed and returned by mail.

Please make sure your dog's rabies shot is up to date. You can look at last year's license and see the rabies expiration date. Send your new certificate if we do not have it on file. There are many options in our area to receive a shot, Tractor Supply, Petco, and Pet Supply to name a few.

All dogs must be vaccinated!

If your dog is no longer with you, please let us know so we can update the record we have on file, and you will not be sent a fine.
