

Thank you again, and enjoy your summer activities. We'll be camping!


## **History of Auto License Plates**

#### INGREDIENTS:

1-1/2 C Flour

1 C Brown Sugar 1-1/2 C Butterscotch Chips

1 C Sugar


2 Eggs 2 C Instant Oatmeal 1 C Shortening

1-1/2 T Baking Soda

1/4 tsp Salt 1/2 tsp Cinnamon

#### DIRECTIONS:

Sift flour, soda, salt & cinnamon; set aside. Cream the shortening and sugars, add eggs and beat.
Add flour mixture and oats, chips mix together. Drop by spoonfills on sheet pans 2 inch. apart.
Bake at 325° for 15 minutes


