



Ryan's 5K Run/Walk (1K Fun Run)



Senior Tax Worker Position Transfer Station Assistant

The Board of Health seeks a Senior Tax Worker to assist at the Transfer Station up to 8 hours per week. Helps residents put their recyclables in the correct containers, assists with placing trash in compactor. May lift up to 50 pounds, with assistance. Senior Tax Workers receive a tax credit up to \$1,000 toward their property taxes for hours worked. To qualify for the Senior Tax Worker Program, you must be a Phillipston resident at least 60 years old, own your own home, and be current on your local tax payments. Open until filled.

The Board's goal is to insure safe, legal, and professional handling of septic waste and garbage that, handled incorrectly or illegally, could endanger the public or the environment. Only the companies listed below are licensed to operate in Phillipston. Please keep this in mind when hiring a provider for trash removal (including dumpsters) or septic cleanout. If you are currently using any other company for these services, please contact the Board of Health so we can get them licensed.


