Dear Friends,

I have been in ministry thirty- three years and have always dreaded the telephone call I received Wednesday morning, April 17. A member of the congregation had been shot in a random shooting at a mall in Tennessee. I was so relieved to meet with John and Nancy at their home in Templeton and learn that he was recovering well. We talked about the shooter and the combination of factors that led to the shooting, an argument with a girl friend, alcohol, a mental health struggle and the fact that he was on probation. And then we talked about the fact that the shooter, as well as the 24 year old female victim were children of God. John looked at me and said, "I believe that he (the shooter) was a child of God." Incredible -- that John could have said that only a week after the shooting.

There are so many reasons that people have told me that these shootings occur. I have heard people blame the media, the NRA, the availability of guns and the shortage of resources for the mentally ill. I don't have the answer, but it could be a combination of these factors. And yet, I will remember the words John spoke, "he was a child of God, and I don't know what his childhood was like." Those words are grace, forgiveness and a Christian man reaching out in empathy to someone who shot a bullet into his body. Could I say the same? Could you? Something to think about in this Easter season.


Ryan's 5K Run/Walk (1K Fun Run)
